

E-MAIL NOTES

A lot of our members are having their e-mail I.D.'s stolen or hi-jacked. I can only tell you to be very careful where you go and how much information that you give out.

When your ID is stolen/hi-jacked the perpetrator has gotten a hold of your e-mail address and password. That means they can log on as you and send mail and it will appear to come from you. The easiest way to stop this is to go into your e-mail account and change your password. If the perpetrator has changed your password then you will not be able to get into your account to change it. In this case you must notify your ISP by phone.

You should never give your password for your e-mail account to anyone. Consider anyone asking for it to be suspect for phishing.

There is difference between a hi-jacked or stolen ID and a Worm. A worm is a program that imbeds itself in your computer and sends itself out to others by using your e-mail or windows address book listings. Older worms would include bits and pieces of text strung together that usually made no sense to compose an e-mail message. The worm itself would be contained in a attachment, which when opened would replicate itself in the current computer. The newer worms seem to be more sophisticated and can contain web links which if you got there will infect your computer.

To report stuff like this most ISP's now support an e-mail address like [abuse@\(yourisp\).com](mailto:abuse@(yourisp).com) or .net. i.e. abuse@att.net or abuse@aol.com to report scams and phishing. You will need to send the message source with the offending e-mail to your ISP. If I get one from you that appears to be a hi-jacking I will send the message and the message source back to you with a note. You can forward the whole thing to your ISP. Do Not under any circumstances click on a web link contained in a hi-jacked e-mail message.

Phishing- An official looking e-mail asking you to supply your e-mail ID and password, or other personal account information.

No legitimate Company will ask for these via e-mail.

Thank goodness the rain is here, a much needed respite from the hot dry days. :)

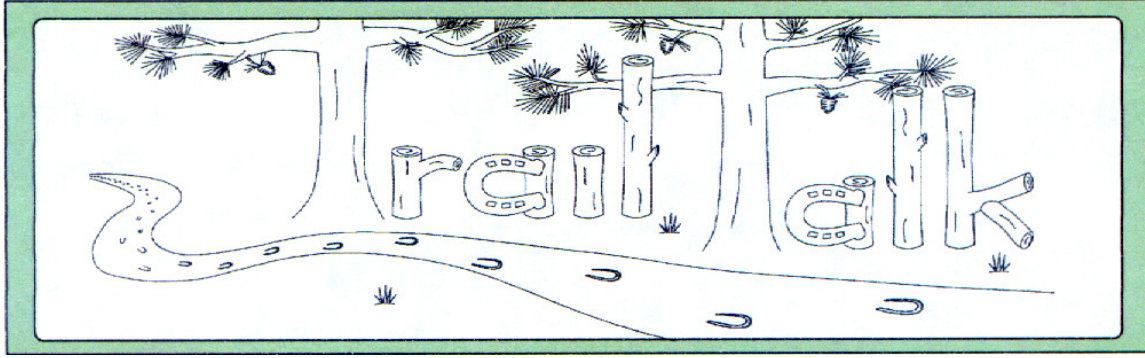
